

Underrepresented in Medicine Funded Visiting Pediatric Rotation

Loma Linda University Department of Pediatrics is excited to welcome qualified senior medical students from backgrounds traditionally underrepresented in medicine to apply for our visiting elective in Pediatrics. In our commitment to cultivate an inclusive and diverse learning environment, we are offering a stipend of up to \$2000 for travel, food and housing expenses in addition to application fees.

This elective is designed to give students an inside look at our Pediatric residency program. To know us is to love us! The 4-week rotation will include both inpatient rounding and outpatient specialty clinic exposure.

Available clinical block dates:

- July 5 to 30, 2021
- August 2 to 27, 2021
- August 30 to September 24, 2021
- September 27 to October 22, 2021

To be considered, an applicant must:

- Be in the final year of their medical training
- Have completed their core clerkship in Pediatrics
- Plan to apply for residency positions in Pediatrics
- Attend an LCME or AOA accredited medical school
- Be a U.S. citizen, Canadian citizen, or permanent resident of the United States
- Identify as belonging to a population that is underrepresented in medicine (as defined by the AAMC)

Following acceptance, applicants must also apply through VSLO. We request that an accepted applicant submit all required VSLO materials **within five business days of acceptance**. Please reference VSLO for a list of these requirements.

Please submit application at least 6 weeks prior to start of rotation date.
