A second chance at life: Ricki Rae's story

Despite having a lingering painful headache, 15-year-old Ricki Rae Guess was determined to get her nails done for high school homecoming. The Guess family could not imagine how quickly their lives would change that day on October 1, 2021.

Only hours later, Ricki Rae's dad, Donnie, called 9-1-1 after Ricki Rae's headache turned into profuse vomiting — she was having a stroke.

Because of her worsening situation, paramedics knew they had to take her to Loma Linda University Children's Hospital. "I will never forget the paramedics said, 'we're losing her,'" says Ricki Rae's mom Shellie.

Scans showed a large mass of blood around Ricki Rae's brain — she needed a craniotomy, but there was a chance she wouldn't survive.

Because of that risk, her family said goodbye. "I remember kissing her and saying, 'please don't leave me, not yet. We have not had enough time,'" Shellie says.

The surgery was successful, but it was only one of three Ricki Rae would have to undergo while in the hospital. Her journey was far from simple, from taking small steps to heal, to being completely paralyzed with no movement or feeling on her left side, to battling infection. However, Ricki Rae finally returned home on Christmas Eve.

Dr. Aaron Robison, one of Ricki Rae's neurosurgeons, and the staff at Children's Hospital helped the Guess family find peace during such an uncertain situation. "I will forever be grateful for Dr. Robison and his team," she says. "Without him, I really believe our daughter would not be here today.

Shellie says it takes an entire community to make Children's Hospital as good as it is — apart from the medical staff, many other things brought joy and healing to Ricki Rae, including someone's donation gift of a sunshine box, receiving a gingerbread house to decorate at Christmas time, and the volunteer dog visits.

"We know there's something really special about Ricki Rae, because she had so many opportunities to leave us," Shellie says. "I'm honored to be her mom, and I can't wait to see what life has in store for her."

Barbara Robinson

Barbara Robinson has dedicated her time and immense talent to communities of the Inland Empire and Loma Linda University Children's Hospital, all while maintaining her professional vocation in banking, which stretched across the Southwest.



Barbara's heart for service drives her active membership on many boards in the Inland Empire. During its infancy, Barbara joined the Loma Linda University Children's Hospital Foundation board and has since served as chair three times, including her current tenure. Her leadership influenced the direction and outcome of fundraising over the course of her term.

To further support Children's Hospital from her office in Riverside, Barbara joined forces with her friends in 2011 and established the Big Hearts for Little Hearts Riverside Guild. Serving as president, Barbara grew the guild into a significant supporter of the young patients.

Under her guidance, the Big Hearts for Little Hearts Riverside Guild has raised over \$500,000 in support of Children's Hospital, funding transport monitors, parent sleeping chairs, vital sign machines, and Ohio infant warmers among other essential medical equipment. Additionally, the guild sponsored two patient rooms and two nurse stations in the Children's Hospital tower for \$100,000.

Professionally, Barbara spent most of her life as one of the most influential women serving the banking industry. She served Bank of America for 35 years, advancing to the Division Executive for the bank's Southwestern Division. Recently, Barbara retired from her position as chief operating officer of Security Bank of California but remains active in the community through her various affiliations with non-profits in the area, including the guild.

Barbara has served in leadership positions with a multitude of organizations, including the National Charity League, University of California Riverside's Board of Trustees, and Monday Morning Group Civic Organization in the Inland Empire. She also served on the board of the Visiting Nurses Association, Riverside Art Museum, Riverside County Philharmonic, and American Heart Association, chairing the Heart Walk for several years.

In recognition of her devotion to improving the lives of others, it is an honor to present Barbara Robinson with the Nancy B. Varner Lifetime Achievement Award.

Douglas Deming, MD

Dr. Douglas Deming is one of the pillars of neonatal and perinatal medicine at Loma Linda University Children's Hospital. Over the course of his 35-plus-year career at the organization, Dr. Deming has served in many roles, including neonatology fellowship program director, director of the neonatal-pediatric ECMO program, medical director of neonatal respiratory care, and chief of the division of neonatology. In one of his most significant roles, he serves to bring tiny babies safely into the world.



Dr. Deming has been actively involved in neonatal research. His findings have been published in more than 50 peer-reviewed publications. An excellent writer and editor, he has co-edited a textbook on chronic lung disease.

Dr. Deming is an outstanding educator and well-respected mentor for medical students, residents, fellows and faculty. With his wealth of medical knowledge and his desire to share that with his learners, Dr. Deming has a unique ability to combine the roles of challenging and supporting each student as they grow and mature in their training. Additionally, he is a highly sought-after lecturer for his command and presentation of medical topics.

Through his many missionary trips to China, Dr. Deming has consistently shown his deep care for communities in need of improving neonatal management. He is revered in the Children's Hospital at Zhejiang University as a mentor, educator and friend, where he has taught techniques, shared protocols, reviewed cases, and given equipment, resources and innumerable lectures to those neonatology teams.

Dr. Deming's commitment to his tiny patients, students, and staff at Children's Hospital reflects the highest level of rigor, quality, and trustworthiness.

2021 RECIPIENT OF THE HOMETOWN HERO AWARD

Dr. Donald and Penny Moores

Penny Moores and her husband Dr. Don Moores embody Loma Linda University Health's motto — to make man whole — through their lifelong friendship with Loma Linda University Children's Hospital. Penny serves as the treasurer for both the Big Hearts for Little Hearts Loma Linda and Desert Guilds, and Dr. Moores serves as division chief of pediatric surgery for Children's Hospital. In addition to the lifesaving care that he and his team provide to our community's children, Dr. Moores can be found by Penny's side during the fund- and friend-raising efforts she promotes.



Together, they provide support and compassion for our patients both inside and outside the operating room.

Penny's passion for young people is exemplified in her countless volunteer hours and behind-the-scenes work that have supported the purchase of crucial lifesaving medical equipment for Children's Hospital. Her tireless efforts, combined with her husband's, have helped the Loma Linda Guild raise more than \$1.7 million and the Desert Guild more than \$3.5 million since their inception. The Guilds have provided arts and crafts, reading books, teddy bears, patient rocking chairs, fetal heart monitors, giraffe warmers, toys for children of all ages and educational tools for the classroom to ensure each child receives the best medical treatment at Children's Hospital.

In addition, Penny provides instrumental support for the annual Children's Hospital Foundation Gala. Penny's aptitude for putting others first has given her a reputation as "the most passionate and tireless lady."
