The BHLH Loma Linda Guild is very excited about our recent association with the LLU Children's Hospital Pediatric

Hematology/Oncology Outpatient Clinic. In addition to our continued support to the inpatient population, we have extended our outreach to include these children who are in prolonged outpatient infusion treatment courses, frequently being seen two to three times each week, for up to three years.



Our contact started with the gift of gingerbread houses the clinic incorporated into their annual holiday parties. When we launched our LEGO® LOVE campaign, we included the outpatient kids by providing age appropriate LEGO® sets and other age-appropriate items to help occupy their time during treatment and then later at home over the long term.
