Important Notes:

- 1. All visits should be requested with a Urinalysis (81002) for *all* Peds Nephrology Patients except nurse visits.
 - a. Patients consult and follow code must be authorized. If any of the additional CPT codes are denied or not covered benefits approve referral with modifications and clear the account.
 - b. Make sure to document a referral note identifying which codes were not authorized and zero out CPT codes on the DX/PX page.
- 2. Renal Biopsy (50200) can be requested with Needle Guide (77002)

Procurement

Blood Pressure:

- a. Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring. Ordered and performed by Peds Nephrology.
- b. Patient comes in to get the B/P kit (CPT 93784), is given instructions, takes kit home for 24 hours and returns the kit to the clinic next day.
- c. If CPT code 93784 has been denied or is not a covered benefit, please deny the referral shell as not a covered benefit and document a note in the referral shell.
- d. Send a CRM to clinic using Topic: Cancel Notification, Subtopic: Patient Not Financially
- e. Follow the standard Authorization procurement Procedure.

Payor Specific Notes:

- Not all payors will approve the Urinalysis (81002) with visits- but the clinic will perform the test regardless.
 - Do not cancel or close referral if 81002 (U/A Dip /Urinalysis) is not approved.
 We want to try and get the auth, but it does not influence the other codes being requested.
